Description of records requested:

Dear Records Access Officer, Pursuant to the New York Freedom of Information Law (Public Officers Law §87 et seq.), I hereby request the following records relating to Professional Standards Section (PSS) Case No. 2024-0084, which involved a traffic accident and complaint filed by Ms. Lan Nguyen-Santiago: Any and all recordings, transcripts, or notes of interviews, written statements, or interrogations of Officer Ryan Fantigrossi conducted as part of the internal investigation into this matter. Any and all body-worn camera (BWC) footage recorded by Officer Ryan Fantigrossi during the incident in question. If BWC was not recorded, I request: Any documentation or explanation provided by the officer or supervisor regarding the absence of BWC footage. The BWC activation/deactivation log for Officer Fantigrossi for the date of the incident. Any additional communications, emails, or internal memos referencing or discussing the incident with Ms. Nguyen-Santiago or the internal complaint (PSS 2024-0084), including any documents relating to decisions about interpreter use or accommodations. If any portions of the requested records are exempt from disclosure, please redact those portions and release the remainder. If the request is too broad or burdensome, I am happy to confer to narrow its scope. Please confirm receipt of this request and advise of any fees prior to processing, if applicable. I request that records be provided in electronic format via email if possible. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
