I think J.D. did what he did for 2 reasons. Veronica being the first, ofc but like...he lives in a house with a borderline psychotic father and he's been constantly exposed to violence, he probably subconsciously knows he's a bad person but maybe he can have at least a small sense of control over the people around him if he killed those he thought were bad...maybe. maybe he can prevent ppl like his father from existing if he kills them. maybe it's his way of having control over his circumstances, maybe he's never been to a school worse than Westerberg. maybe killing these people is like killing the next versions of his father to him.

Obviously he wouldn't be...like himself if his dad wasn't, well, his dad. his actual introduction to Veronica involved him saying something negative about his father, and some other things.
