

0138-D (T) - Hedge Maze

Description: Miniature labyrinth approx. 5 feet by 5 feet, with artificial hedges 4-6 inches high. Pathways observe right angles only and are uniformly 2 inches wide. Exact mapping has proven difficult as layout is subject to periodic change.

Notes: Reporting dead insects, rodents or other small animals within the centre of the maze (outside of testing) is unnecessary. Routine cleaning will take care of remains before smell becomes a problem.

0139-E (S) - Iron Maiden

Description: 7 foot high iron maiden torture device, constructed of reinforced bronze. Design circa 17th century, with double hinged opening. Topped with molded bronze design resembling bearded head of roughly middle age.

Notes: Kept triple-padlocked at all time. Not to be opened without express permission and presence of both Head of Storage and Head of Institute. Report any noticeable change in expression of bronze face.

0140-D (S) - Mirror Frame

Description: Gold-plated mirror frame of baroque design. Creation circa 1850. Frame is empty with no glass inside.

Notes: Velvet cover to be kept firmly in place over entirety of the item. Any instance of the covering being removed should be reported. Any instance of seeing a reflection in such an uncovered mirror should be reported as a matter of urgency.

0141-C (S) - Ladder

Description: Hailo brand A-frame conversion ladder, aluminium construction. Top three rungs missing, apparently sheared off.

Notes: Not to be used for renovation or maintenance. *DO NOT ALLOW USE BY CONTRACTORS.*

0142-E (T) - Crate of Soil

Description: Wooden crate, volume of 64 cubic feet. Filled to brim with hard-packed soil of likely South East Asian origin. No lid.

Notes: Do not dig into soil. Any clear words (or phonetic transcription for non-English communication) discernible from beneath the soil should be noted down and recorded. This includes any communication heard outside of standard testing cycle, especially if conversation is achieved.

0143-B (T) - Kerosene Lamp

Description: Handheld kerosene oil lamp, lit, with cracked porcelain base. Painted blue flower design. Wick length consistently 1/2 inch.

Notes: Not to be removed from box except during testing. Please ensure all clothing and items within 2 feet are fully fireproofed. Burn cream kept in adjacent cabinet. Ensure area otherwise lit as lamp does not provide illumination.

0144-A (S) - Ball of String

Description: Large ball of red-dyed jute twine string, measuring approx. 54 metres unspooled.

Notes: Testing permanently suspended after complications with record-keeping. Keep away from any Institute staff currently involved in active investigations or research projects.

0145-A (T) - Fountain Pen

Description: One Parker Duofold "Big Red" pen circa 1928. No box.

Notes: Not to be removed from Storage. Anyone attempting to use the pen, even outside of standard testing cycle, should ensure the written result is properly submitted (regardless of message content) for analysis of DNA and blood type.

0146-D (S) - Tapestry

Description: Woven tapestry measuring approx. 12 foot by 20 foot. Circa 1730. Depiction of an open eye, apparently human, in front of small, closely-written alchemical symbols and formulae.

Notes: To be kept in place on the wall of storage room B. It is advisable to avoid placing large items in front of it. Extended eye contact with the tapestry is also to be avoided.

0147-B (S) - Screaming Head

Description: The head of an unidentified caucasian male of approx. 60 years of age, shaved bald. Head has continued screaming, despite lack of lungs, since acquisition.

Notes: Ensure head is kept in sealed soundproof box at all times. *NOT TO BE USED FOR FURTHER PRANKS.*
