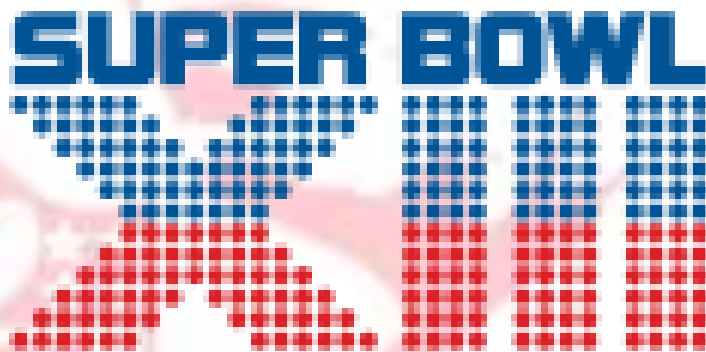

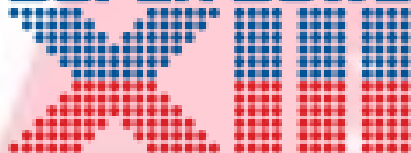

STRICT RULES: All uniforms must conform with NFL 67 BIG MEN teams.

#1 and #2 Seeds get a Bye

#4 Seed plays #5 Seed

#3 Seed plays #6 Seed

### PLAYOFF RULES:

- ✓ HOME TEAM GETS THE COINTOSS CALL. The home team is the team with the best interleague play record, or best record
- ✓ **ALL DISPUTES ARE RESOLVED WITH A COIN TOSS.**
- ✓ Team with best record gets home field advantage throughout playoffs
- ✓ Best Record in NFL gets Home Field in Super Bowl—if tie record it goes best conference record.
- ✓ Kick-off's from End Zone WITH PLAYERS LINING UP AT THE 40 YARDLINE ON THE KICK-OFF'S.
- ✓ There will be 4 timeouts total for each team, 2 each half for 60 minutes for each team.
- ✓ Out-of-bounds players are disqualified from receiving a pass—all players must be in-bounds to complete reception--including Super Bowl.
- ✓ **In a solitaire** game only one-pass per series or first down, otherwise if there are two people playing--pass at will just as they do in NFL.
- ✓ **TACKLES:** It is considered a Tackle by the defender when the front or front two corners of the defenders player base touches the ball carrier, except rushing ... if a player from the defense is side by side touching the base on a rushing play, it is considered a tackle.
- ✓ If the ball carrier is running behind a defender touching the back of the base of the defender in front of the rusher, it is NOT a tackle.
- ✓ There must always be five men on the line, three guards and two tackles.
- ✓ The offense sets up the play first.
- ✓ Each coach has 45 seconds to set up the play—there are no exceptions to this rule. A ten-yard penalty is enforced if the coach does not set up the play.
- ✓ We do not allow people to turn players around to chase players in this league. The play is the play.
- ✓ The Receivers **MUST** be lined up at least 3 to 4 inches away from the line men, except on the 2-yard line.





- ✓ Two attempts to kick (extra-point or field goal) up until 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter where that rule is eliminated, and you get only one attempt.
- ✓ You only get one pass attempt. Questionable catches require a flip of the coin for a do-over when both coaches cannot agree on a catch with the person who passed calling the coin-toss in the air.
- ✓ If any player with ball with any part of the base crosses any white line in the endzone it is ruled a touchdown.
