Preparing for Show Season

But seriously we need to always check to make sure our equipment is safe and ready to start the show season.

National EDGE&TA Facebook Page

The Directors have been working on something new. We now have a National EDGE&TA Facebook page. We want to give each branch the opportunity to have their events and photos put on a National page. Each Branch President can send one person's name into their Regional Director, and me, to give that person administrative access to the page. That person can get photos and information put on our Facebook page. We are hoping this will give us more exposure and share our hobby with people across the country. We know that a lot of people take pictures and videos at our shows, parades, plow days and pulls. Hopefully we can encourage everyone to send those in to the person from their branch to put these on the Facebook page. We are trying to get someone from all the branches to be able to post on this page and keep people informed about EDGE&TA events around the country. If you have a personal Facebook page, please go on there and search for the National page and like and follow. The more followers we have, the more times the page will be viewed and the more publicity EDGE&TA will get. We thought that this would be a way to reach out to more people and get more members nationwide.

Certificates of Additionally Insured and Proof of Insurance Certificate

On another note, Certificates of Additionally Insured and proof of Insurance Certificate need to be sent in at least 20 days before you need them. We have mentioned this multiple times but still have branches that wait until the last minute. One branch recently sent one in five days before it was needed. I was called on the last day, which was a Friday. I tried to contact the insurance agent, but the office was closed that day and the branch did Not receive their Certificate. Please check the date that the landowner needs the Certificate. Sometimes they need it two weeks ahead of the event.

National Dues and Membership

The National dues will remain at \$20 per person for 2026. Please remember to send your checks and the completed membership form, including the correct number of people, to Tina Brown. Her name and address are on the last page of this newsletter. Please try to send in the bulk of your membership by mid-March so we have the funds available to pay the large insurance bill by April 15th.

Upcoming Director Positions

In 2026 we have three National Directors terms ending. The SW, NW and Director at Large positions will be open. So, if anyone wants to apply for one of these positions, just send an application to Tina by May 15th. If there is more than one person applying for the position, there will be a vote with each branch in the region having one vote.

Hall of Fame Nominations

Hall of Fame for 2026 is now open. All applications will be due by April 18th with the awards announced at the National Show in Huntley, Montana on August 15th. Send all writeups into the Hall of Fame Chairman.

Regional and National Shows for 2026 and 2027

Regional Shows are needed for 2026. We need one for the Southwest, Central and Eastern Regions. The Northwest is hosting the National Show in August in Huntley, Montana. Please talk to your members and contact your Director or me to talk about hosting one if you are interested. We also will need a National Show for 2027. That year it will be held in the Southwest Region. Each branch hosting the Regional Show receives \$500 and the branch hosting the National Show receives \$1000 to go toward expenses.

Once again, please forward this newsletter to all your branch members that have email. It is just the click of a button. We are trying to get this information out to as many people as possible. I still talk to members of the organization that don't have a clue that we even have a National newsletter as they have never seen one. 
