About our school

History:

Holy Trinity Academy of Calamba had its humble beginnings in the subdivision of Villa de Calamba, Calamba City. It was started and founded by a teacher who desired to share the Gospel and God's Word to the residents of Villa de Calamba. As a Christian, she strongly believed that the firm foundation for life was a life obedient and committed to Jesus Christ and a life of nurturing devotion and intimacy with Him. It is from this foundation that individuals will conquer obstacles and pressures in life and to live a fruitful and excellent life pleasing and honoring to God. In 2006, the school started with 1 teacher and 17 preschool pupils in a rented unit. Due to the suggestions and encouragement of parents to start thinking about providing elementary education and prayer from families and friends, the Lord provided a place to expand the school in Barandal, Calamba City. Before the pandemic last SY 2019-2020, we had 24 teachers and a population of more than 500 pupils and students from preschool to Grade 12.

For school years of 2020-2021 and 2021-2022, due to the pandemic, we created a distance education program to meet the needs of students from the comfort and safety of his/her home. We continued to reach out to our students in a very personal way ensuring that teachers and students meet in the "virtual" classroom. For SY 2022-2023, we adopted a 100% face-to-face instruction. We plan to continue a 100% face-to-face instruction for school year 2023-2024.

Despite the uncertainty of tomorrow, we remain strongly committed to partner with parents to raise up kids who are "maka-Diyos, makatao, makakalikasan, at makabansa." As a school, we believe that education is the key to change the plights of many families and ultimately, to transform our beloved nation inside and out. We

strongly believe it is our responsibility to pass the baton to our students the strong sense of nationalism and nation-building through the formation of godly character and passion for God. We proclaim that we will do our part to be a beacon of light to the community, to send the message of hope of the Gospel to all the families who enter our school, and to the rest of the world. We continue our commitment to serve God in this ministry in equipping our pupils and students to be God-fearing and responsible adults who will devote their lives to honoring God. Curriculum:

The heart of our school is that Jesus is our model Teacher, who taught others by example applying gentleness, self-control, compassion, wisdom and love and all this done through obedience to our Father in heaven. While this is a hard act to follow, we live in faith that He will be the one to teach and train our students to be the best they can be for Him. Our curriculum emphasizes on the 3 aspects:

I. Spiritual Development:

- 4. To promote work experiences which develop the child's orientation to the world of work and creativity and prepare himself to engage in honest and gainful work.

Section 22: Objectives of Secondary Education- The objectives of secondary education are:

- 1. To continue to promote the objectives of elementary education; and
- 2. To discover and enhance the different aptitudes and interests of the student so as to equip him with the skills for productive endeavor and /or prepare him for tertiary schooling.
