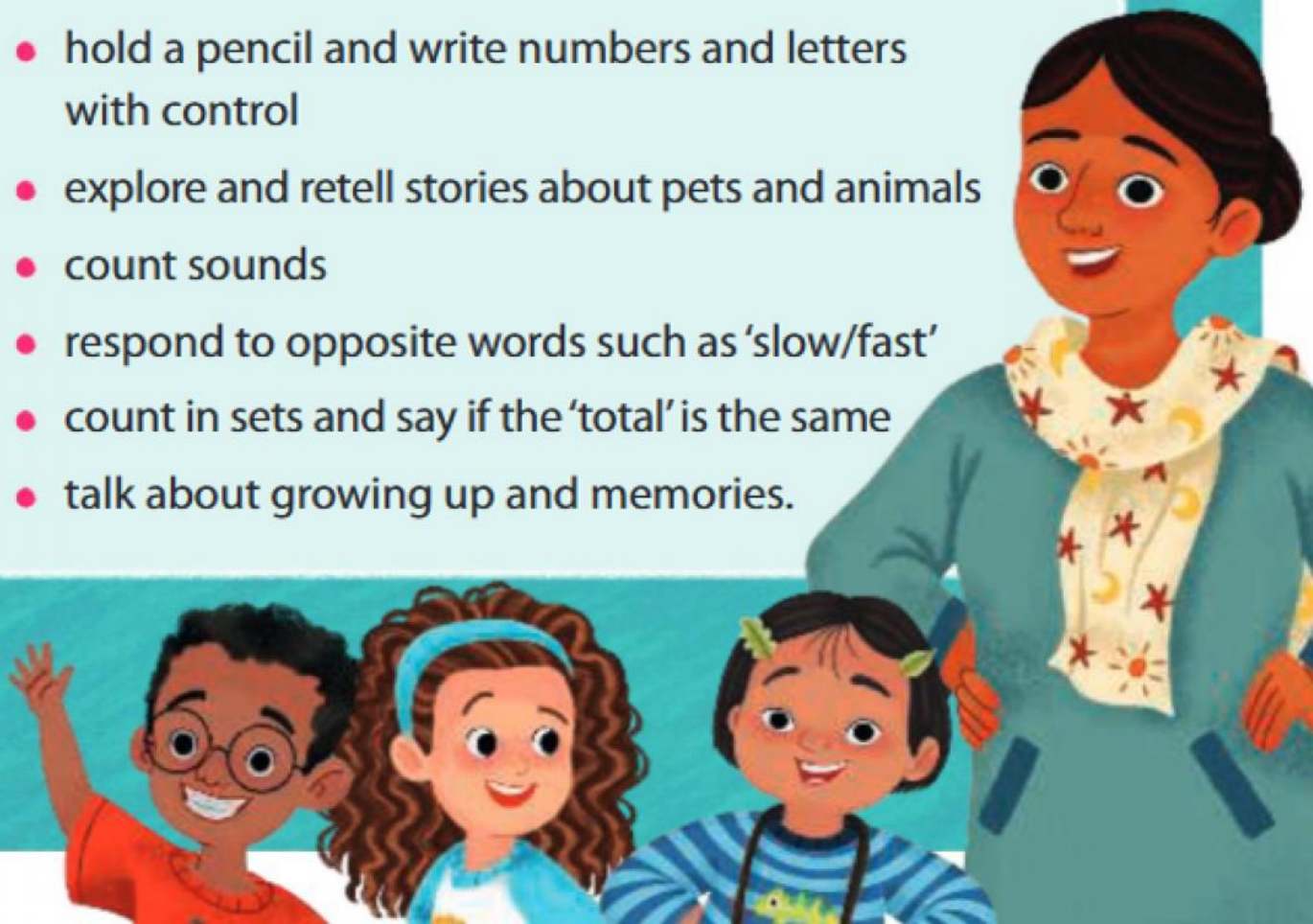
Amazing animals

In this topic, learners are encouraged to:

- explore the concept of zero
- recognize and follow numbers 1 to 10 in order
- talk and ask questions about animals and their babies
- join in with rhymes and songs
- identify animals' homes.

Teachers will also help learners to:

- hold a pencil and write numbers and letters with control
- explore and retell stories about pets and animals
- count sounds
- respond to opposite words such as 'slow/fast'
- count in sets and say if the 'total' is the same
- talk about growing up and memories.
