In this topic, learners are encouraged to:

- trace and colour, using the correct pencil grip
- count up to 20
- arrange events in the right order
- retell a story
- identify familiar shapes.

Teachers will also help learners to:

- write familiar letters and spell simple words
- explore different ways of showing numbers
- discuss good hygiene, like washing their hands
- explore the world outdoors
- learn about their bodies and how to use them.
