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Weather fun

In this topic, learners are encouraged to:

- name and create weather sounds
- explore the composition of numbers to 12
- identify repeating patterns
- sort items into sets by pattern and colour
- compare things.

Teachers will also help learners to:

- create and record sound effects
- respond to and make their own weather art
- make cloud craft and their own designs
- explore properties of different materials
- learn role-play skills to enact a fable
- put together a collage
- arrange repeating patterns.
