

Woman Hurt Slightly In 2-Car Crash

CLARION — A Colorado woman was slightly injured in a two-car crash which occurred at 3:45 p.m. Saturday on Route 66, north of the Route 322 intersection.

Mary Cecelia Smith of Denver, Colo., was treated at Clarion Hospital for neck injuries and released.

She was driving a 1969 Ford coupe north on Route 66 and was attempting to make a left turn into a private driveway when her car was struck from the rear by a vehicle operated by Edward Niederriter of Shippenville.

Niederriter was reportedly driving too fast for road conditions. Damages of approximately \$150 resulted to Niederriter's car, a 1970 Ford sedan.

Damages totaled approximately \$275 in a two-car mishap which happened at 1:30 a.m. Sunday on Route 68 in Rimersburg Borough. No injuries were reported.

Involved in the crash were Howard Goodman of Warren, operating a 1969 Ford station-wagon and Gilbert Wagner of Huey, driving a 1969 Ford coupe.

The accident occurred as Wagner, traveling north, stopped on the road to make a left turn. He was rammed from the rear by Goodman's vehicle.

No one was injured as a car and truck-snow plow collided at 9:10 a.m. Sunday, on Route 322, west of Shippenville.

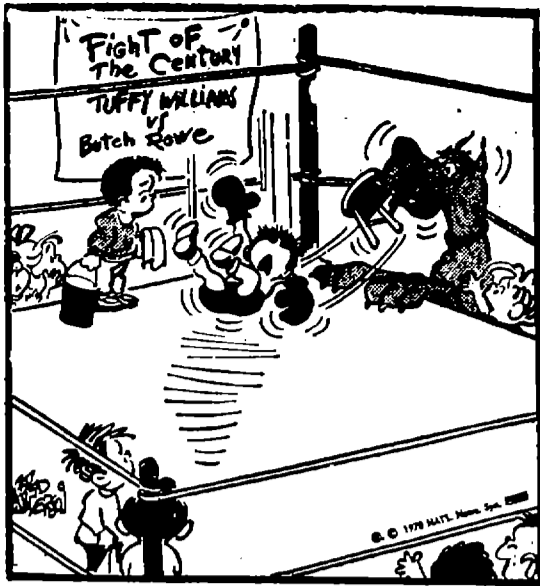
Charles Wingard of Shippenville RD 1 was operating an International truck-snow plow and traveling east on Route 322. He was attempting to make a left turn onto a township road.

A 1966 Pontiac coupe, driven by Charles Weaver of Kossuth, attempted to pass Wingard's truck. Weaver's vehicle struck the snow plow blade, spinning the auto into a slide. Damages were light.

There were no injuries reported as the result of a two-car incident at 3:30 p.m. Saturday on Route 322 west of Kossuth.

Mariam Couris of Cuvahoga Falls, Ohio, driving a 1966 Ford coupe, pulled from a township road into the path of a car driven by Charles Swann of West Monterey.

Damages were estimated at \$300 to the Swann auto, a 1971 Dodge sedan and at \$300 to the Couris car.

23 PC Railroad Cars Derailed

LATROBE, Pa. (AP) — Some 23 cars of a 62-car freight train derailed near here Sunday morning, blocking all three mainline tracks of the Penn Central railroad.

A company spokesman said the accident happened as the train, en route from Conway to Wilkes-Barre, was crossing a bridge. One car plunged over 100 feet into the Loyahanna Creek and several others dangled from the span.

There were no injuries reported, and the cause of the mishap hadn't been determined.

The spokesman said it would probably take wreck crews until Monday morning to restore traffic on the mainline.
