In connection with the movement for a memorial bridge at Washington Crossing, arrangements should be made if possible either with the Washington Crossing Park Commission now at work or by its repeal in the 1931 Legislature, doing away with Chapter 75, P.L. 1923 which created a special commission for this bridge project. Such commission seems entirely unnecessary except perhaps for its propoganda and in any case its plans and progress will have to be reconciled with those of the Board of Conservation and Development in connection with the approaches to any bridge on the New Jersey side.
