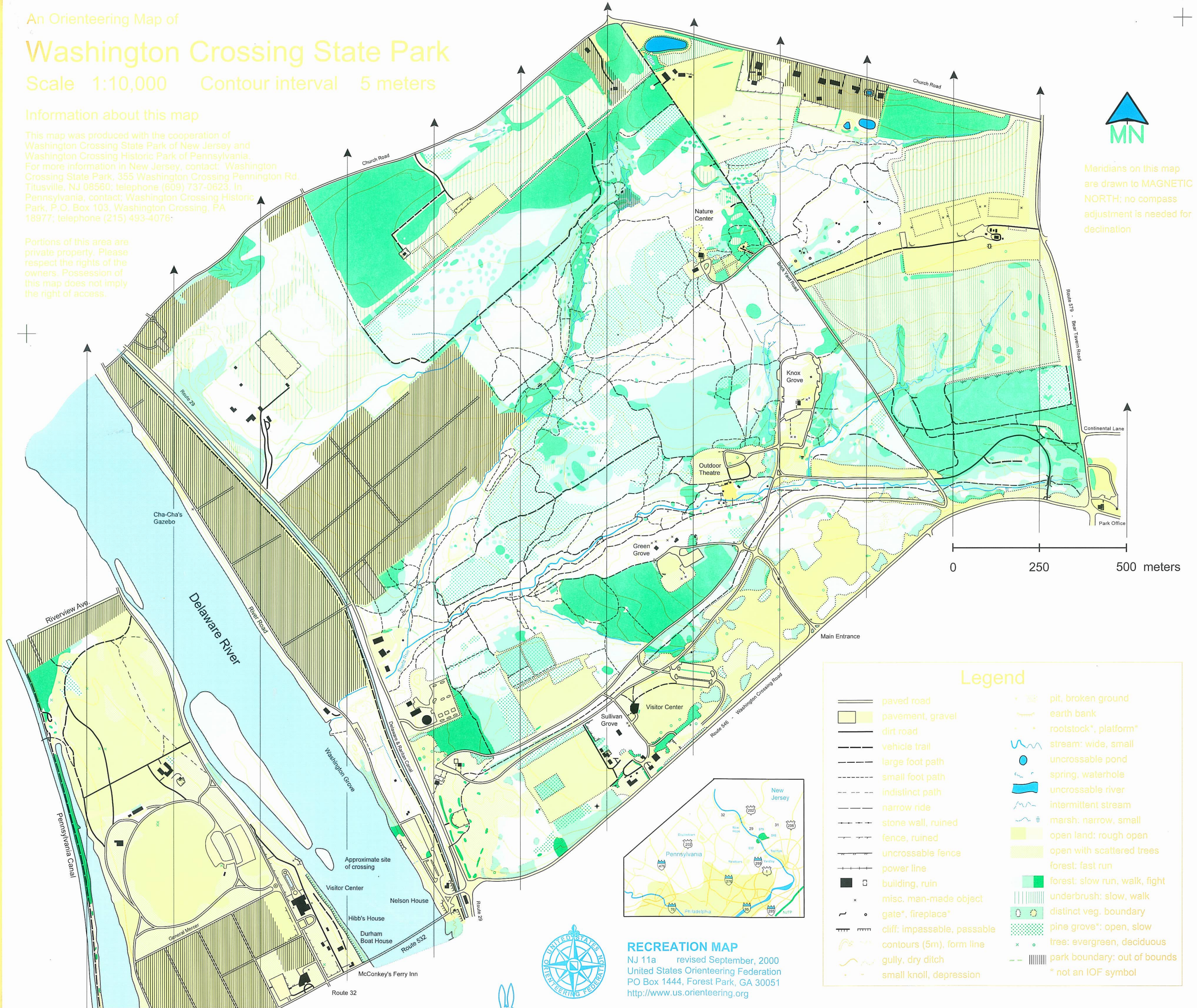


An Orienteering Map of

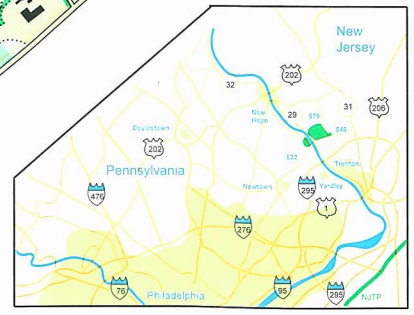


Meridians on this map are drawn to MAGNETIC NORTH; no compass adjustment is needed for declination
