Washington Crossing People Get Concession From the Pennsylvania Railroad Company

Residents of Washington Crossing have filed a petition with the State Public Utility Commission, asking that the grade crossing over the Pennsylvania Railroad tracks be safeguarded. F. L. Sheppard, general superintendent of the New York Division of the Pennsylvania Railroad, has replied to the notice of the complaint sent to it by the commission, stating that a day watchman will be stationed at the crossing in connection with the work of opening the canal bridge, near the crossing.
