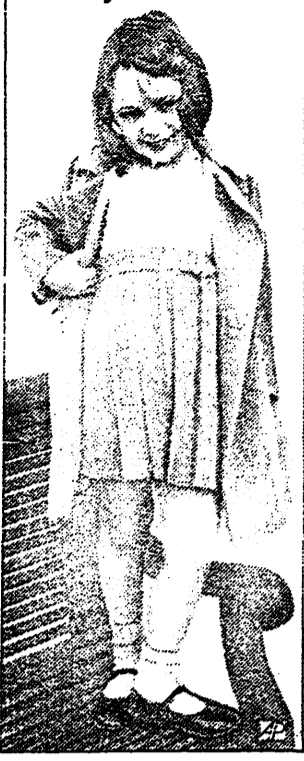


Scout Camporal At Crossing Park
