G. Wallace Conover, publisher of the paper, said distribution of today's 46-page issue, the largest in the history of the paper would be made as usual.

The large issue was entirely due to an unusual amount of Christ-

mas advertising, he said.

The printers, members of Local 38. International Typographical Union (AFL) went on strike yesterday, demanding reduction of the work week from 40 hours to 35, and higher hourly pay. They asked \$82.25 for 35 hours at a rate of \$2.35, instead of \$82 for 10 hours at a rate of \$2.05.

Conover said today's issue was put out by 20 employes from other departments and "friends" of the paper. He said he planned to continue publication, "by the best means possible," but did not amplify the statement.

No further negotiations are scheduled at the present time, Conover said. The union last night rejected a




