Book 4 Red Stamps A8 through Z8 and A5 through C5 now valid indefinitely.

Processed Foods

Book Four Blue Stamps A8 through Z8 and A5 through F5 now valid and good indefinitely.

Sugar

Book Four Stamps 30, 31 and 32 good for five pounds indefinitely; Stamp 40 valid for five pounds for home canning through February 28, 1945; use Spare Stamp 37 for canning applications to local boards.

Shoes

Book Three airplan. Stamps 1 and 2 good indefinitely.

Gasoline

Eleven-A coupons now valid for three gallons and good through November 8.

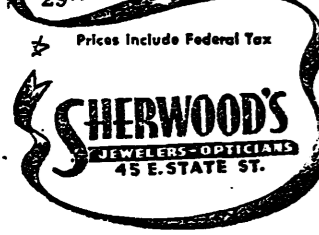
Fuel Oil

Period four and five coupons valid in all areas through September 30.

Rent

Every rented unit must be registered with Area Rent Office.

Each change of tenancy must be reported to the Area Rent Office within five days.

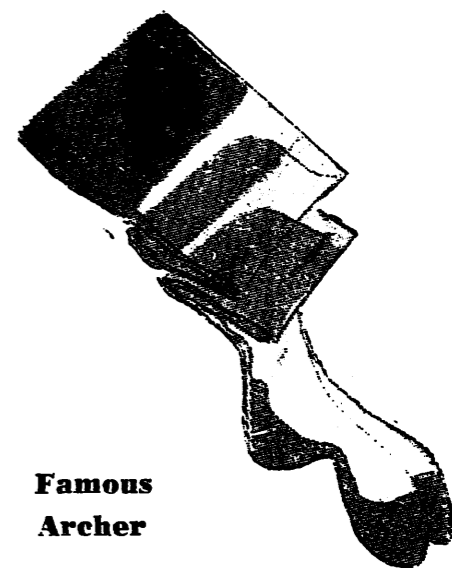

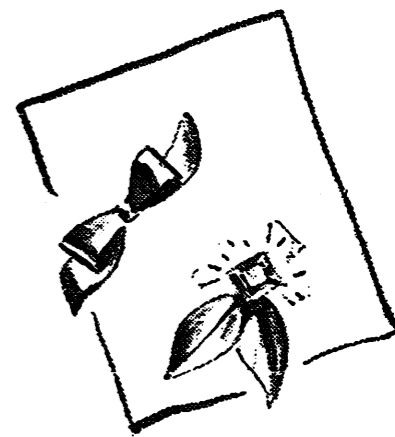

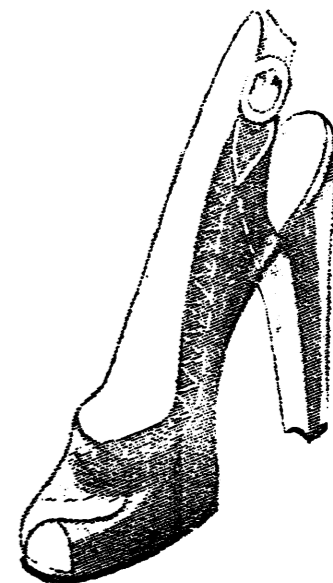
