CHOCOLATE CARAMELS. One pint brown sugar, one mill of milk, one-half pint of molasses, one-half ounce unweetened chocolate, one ounce of butter, and a half of one tablespoonful of extract of vanilla. Boil all except the vanilla over a slow fire until the ingredients are dissolved and stir occasionally afterward, as it is liable to burn. Test it by dropping a little in cold water, and if it hardens quickly, remove at once from the fire, and add the extract and pour into buttered tins. When cool, mark the squares with a buttered knife.

Butter Scotch. Two cups of syrup, one cup of butter, one cup of sugar, and one cup of vanilla. Boil the syrup and butter until it is thick, then add the sugar and vanilla, and stir until it is smooth.
