

TO URGE ACTION ON PARK PROJECT

Mayor Donnelly and Prosecutor Martin P. Devlin are to be among the speakers tomorrow afternoon at the meeting in the State House to urge that action be taken to develop the Washington-Crossing memorial park.

The views of the commission which formerly had charge of this work will be given by Col. William Libbey.

The Department of Conservation and Development now has charge of the park but has not taken steps to have it developed but has called the meeting to hear expressions of opinion. As the Legislature plans to adjourn tomorrow no money will be allowed for the project this year but plans can be formulated for the next session.
